The electrical design and build was completed by leading office fit-out and shopfitting contractor Batchelor Electrical and included extensive new works to lighting, small power, data, mains distribution and computer controlled access control.

The 40,000 square foot premises spanning a 1.89 acre site have been totally modernised to reduce its impact on the environment; from the solar-powered water heater and lowenergy PIR controlled office lighting to the latest high-tech chipper and biomass burner.
